Welcome to the Center for Health Interprofessional Practice and Education's (CHIPE's) Virtual Interprofessional Health Showcase! This is our 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Interprofessional Health Showcase which transitioned to a virtual format as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic and subsequent social distancing measures. We are excited to celebrate the amazing work of our students and residents on their health-related projects related to community engagement, quality improvement, research, case studies, and literature reviews.

As you can see from the list of posters, project collaborators range from schools and programs across UT. Authors include students from undergraduate, graduate, and professional programs, as well as residents. We are thrilled that 40% of abstracts were submitted by interprofessional teams, meaning authors from two or more professions collaborated on each of these projects. Additionally, 51% of projects involved community partners. Similar to our live showcase, judges reviewed posters to determine best in research, literature review, case studies, community engagement, quality improvement, interprofessional team, project in progress, and visual. New this year is the "People's Choice Award" where showcase attendees can vote for their top 3 favorite projects. A link to vote is provided on our website.
