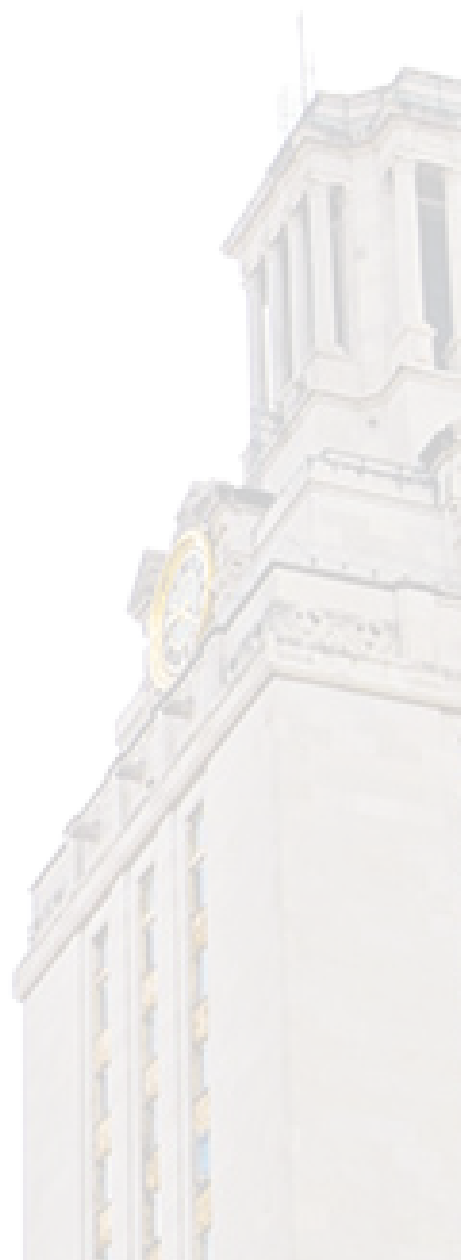

CHIPE is very excited to showcase innovations from interprofessional collaborators from many schools, programs, and professions across UT and beyond. Authors include students from undergraduate, graduate, and professional programs, as well as residents. We are thrilled that **33% of abstracts were submitted by interprofessional teams**, meaning authors from two or more professions collaborated on each of these projects. Additionally, **62% of projects involved community partners**. Finalists will compete in "Best in" categories that include community engagement, health innovation, research, and quality improvement. Three other award categories, visual, project-in-progress, and interprofessional project, will also be selected.
